Introduction

The plan to build a new library for Kaslo and District has been well supported by the community. The existing library is small, in a poor location, lacks program and office space, and the interior is dark. These factors limit the size of the collection and the programs and services the library can offer.

Working towards a new facility was a strategic goal in the previous plan. The land has been purchased and considerable design work has been completed. The proposed library is a single-storey building, designed to be net carbon zero certified and fully accessible throughout. Separate program and meeting rooms will be available for the library and other community groups. Fundraising for the new library continues through grants, fundraising events, and private donations.

Kaslo & District Public Library Strategic Plan 2024-2026

This Strategic Plan is an interim plan to carry the library forward until funding for a new library facility has been secured and a more formal strategic planning process is undertaken. This plan brings forward items from the 2019-2023 Strategic Plan that are the continued focus of the KDPL Board.

The Board approved this strategic plan on November 23, 2023.
